## MAURITIUS CITIZENSHIP ACT

### FACT SHEET No. 6

#### Section 14(2) – Registration as citizen of Mauritius of a person who has ceased to be a citizen of Mauritius following renunciation of Mauritius Citizenship

1. A person of full age and capacity who has ceased to be a citizen of Mauritius upon making a declaration of renunciation may apply for resumption and may be registered as a Citizen of Mauritius.

#### HOW TO APPLY

2. #### APPLICATION PROCEDURES

3. **The duly filled in Application Form has to be subscribed in Mauritius, in the presence of a Judge or the Master & Registrar of the Supreme Court or a District Magistrate, prior to submission.**

4. The following supporting documents in original and one photocopy should accompany the application **(clean and legible copies on A4 format)**:-

5. A non-refundable application fee of **Rs 2,000** should be paid upon submission of the application.

6. Upon approval, a **prescribed fee of Rs 15,000 is payable** at the Cash Office of the Prime Minister's Office, Level 2, Government Centre, Port Louis and thereafter the Certificate of Registration is issued within **one month**.

7. If the application is not approved, the applicant is notified accordingly by way of a letter.

#### DEPRIVATION OF CITIZENSHIP

8. Any person who has acquired citizenship by registration may be deprived of that citizenship if the registration has been obtained by means of fraud, false representation or the concealment of any material fact.

#### NOTE

- **All foreign documents should be duly apostilled in country of origin.**
- **Any change of name should be made executory in Mauritius.**
- **Application shall be made by applicant in person.**
- **An affidavit might be requested if ever there are discrepancies in the names.**
- **Only a complete dossier with all relevant documents will be accepted.**
- **Any other document deemed necessary might also be requested, by this Office.**
- **Processing of applications generally requires 12 months.**
- **No reason will be given for the refusal of any application under the Act.**
