Caution: - Section 20(1) of the Mauritius Citizenship Act, 1968 provides that: -

"Any person who for the purpose of procuring anything to be done or not to be done under this Act or under Regulation made under this Act makes any statement which he knows to be false in a material particular, or recklessly makes any statement which is false in a material particular, shall be liable on conviction to imprisonment for a term not exceeding one year or to a fine not exceeding one thousand rupees."

Section 195 of the Courts Ordinance provides that: -

# FACT SHEET No. 2

# Section 6 – Registration of Minor Children

1. A minor child of a citizen of Mauritius may be registered as a citizen under this section by the parent or the guardian of the child.

#### HOW TO APPLY

#### APPLICATION PROCEDURES

- A declaration in the form set out in the application form has to be subscribed in Mauritius in the presence of a Judge or the Master & Registrar of the Supreme Court or a District Magistrate, prior to submission.
- The following supporting documents in <u>original</u> and <u>two photocopies</u> should accompany the application (<u>clean</u> and legible copies on A4 format):-
  - Full/Unabridged Birth certificate of minor child (duly apostilled in the country of birth (a) if child was born abroad);

Recent copies (Less than 1

vear)

Full/Unabridged Birth certificates of parents or guardian (duly apostilled in country of birth); (b) Marriage certificate of parents (if applicable, duly apostilled in country of marriage if (c)

celebrated abroad);

- Mauritius National Identity Card and Passport of Mauritian parent/s; (d)
- First five pages of minor's passport(passport valid for at least 6 months); (e)
- The certificate of registration or naturalization of the child's parent, if the latter is a Mauritian citizen by *(f)* registration or naturalization;
- Residence permit of minor in Mauritius; (g)
- (h) Attestation letter from minor's school in Mauritius;
- The certificate of foreign nationality of the child's parent (if applicable); and (*i*)
- Photocopies of References' Mauritius National Identity Card and phone numbers. (*j*)
- A non-refundable application fee of **Rs 2,000** should be paid upon submission of the application. 5.
- 6. Upon approval, a **prescribed fee of Rs 20,000 is payable** at the Cash Office of the Prime Minister's Office, Level 2, Government Centre, Port Louis and thereafter the Certificate of Registration is issued within one month.
- 7. If the application is not approved, the applicant will be notified accordingly by way of a letter.

### VALIDITY OF A CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION

A Certificate of Registration issued under the Mauritius Citizenship Act is valid for an indefinite period and it 8. should be kept safely as no duplicate is issued in case of loss.

#### **DEPRIVATION OF CITIZENSHIP**

9. Any person who has acquired citizenship by registration may be deprived of that citizenship if the registration has been obtained by means of fraud, false representation or the concealment of any material fact.

# **NOTE**

- All foreign documents should be duly apostilled in country of origin.
- Any change of name should be made executory in Mauritius.
- Application shall be made by applicant in person.
- Only a complete dossier with all relevant documents will be accepted.
- An affidavit might be requested if ever there are discrepancies in the names.
- Any other documents deemed necessary might also be requested, by this Office.
- Processing of applications generally requires a minimum of one (1) year.
- No reason will be given for the refusal of any application under the Act.
